# Santa's Fun Run

Sunday 7<sup>th</sup> December 2008

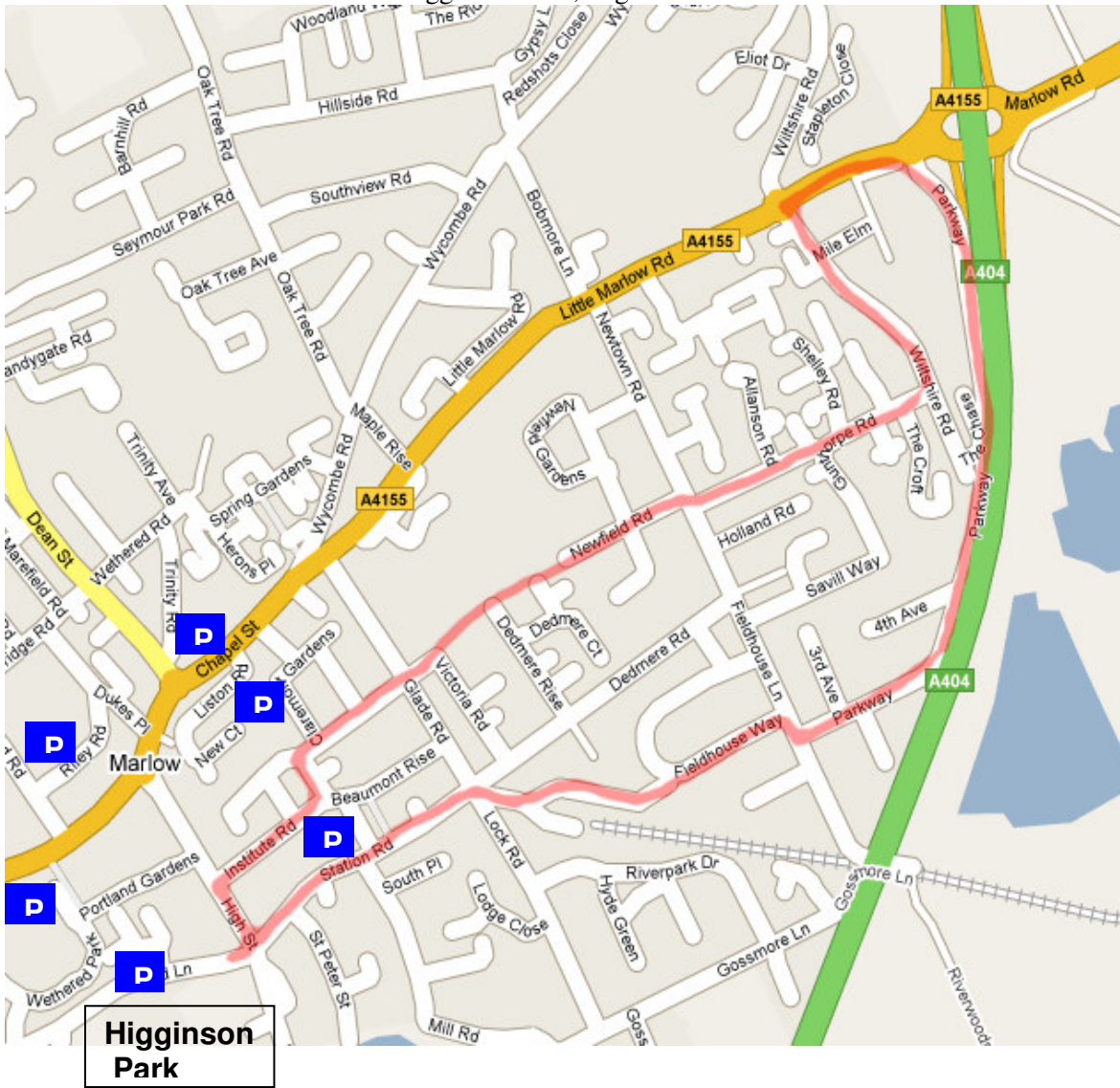
**Thank you for entering the fourth Marlow Santa's Fun Run. Please read this sheet which gives you information to help you make the most of the event. The route is shown on the reverse.**

1. If you have received this sheet with your running number *and* your free Santa costume there is no need for further registration. Just make sure you are at the starting line by 9.55am at the latest.
2. If you have received your documentation through the post, you will need to collect your free Santa costume from the Higginson Room, Court Garden: just hand in the costume voucher enclosed in your entry pack. It would be helpful if you could clearly print your email address on the voucher before handing it in. The room is open for costume collection from 8.30am on Sunday morning.
3. Limited changing facilities are available in the Park, so we advise you to arrive in your running gear.
4. A free baggage holding area is also available in the Higginson Room from 8.30am. Just show your runner's number and hand over your bag for safe keeping. Please note that whilst Rotarians will be on duty during the event, the organizers cannot be held responsible for any losses. Represent your race number to collect your bag afterwards.
5. Your runner's number must be worn on the *front* of your costume and to be eligible for one of the prizes you must wear your Santa costume throughout the Fun Run.
6. The start and finish area is clearly marked on the footpath at the rear of Court Garden, 100 yards to the east of the terrace. All runners should be in position by 9.55am as the run will start promptly at 10am. Do please ensure you arrive in plenty of time to park, collect your costume and leave belongings for safe keeping.
7. There will be a water drinks station about halfway around course, and another one at the finish in Higginson Park.
8. All finishers will receive a runner's medal after they cross the finishing line. If you are an event winner please make your way to the Higginson Room before 11.30am for the prize giving.
9. Public toilets are adjacent to the Higginson Room and also close to the Higginson Park exit.
10. The café in Court Garden will be open from 8.30 am where toilets are also available. The car park is open permanently and the charge is £1.00 for two hours and £1.50 for three etc. Other public pay and display car parks are marked on the map overleaf.
11. The route is mostly on hard surface but there are short lengths of grass where care is needed, and as it is autumn be careful on wet leaves. Only Station Road (from the High Street to the Marlow Donkey) will be closed so elsewhere you must keep to the footpaths. Marshals will be at all road crossings to control traffic: please comply with their instructions at all times. Please remember that as a pedestrian you do not have right of way on the road (other than at pedestrian crossings).
12. St John Ambulance will be on duty near the start and finish area and the majority of marshals will be in phone contact. If an issue arises please inform the nearest marshal.
13. The organisers of the Marlow Santa Fun Run cannot accept responsibility for any injury, loss or damage however caused.
14. Should the event not take place for whatever reason, entrants will not be entitled to a refund.
15. Remember this is a charity event and your support in raising sponsorship money is much appreciated. Please send this as soon as possible to P.C. Bailey, 'Woodwinds', Henley Road, Marlow, SL7 2BZ with cheques payable to "RC of Marlow Thames Charity Account".
